SAFEGUARDING STAYING SAFE

You have the right to be and feel safe from all forms of abuse.



CHILD ON CHILD SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND ABUSE

No one should touch you in a manner that makes you feel uncomfortable or upset. No one should make suggestive, sexual remarks to you, either in-person or online. Anyone under 18 is legally a child.



PHYSICAL ABUSE

No one should touch you in any way that physically hurts. This could include hitting, pushing, slapping, kicking or holding you back.



DOMESTIC ABUSE

No one should harm threaten or control you. This includes family, other people you live with or partner/ex-partner.



HONOUR-BASED ABUSE

No one should force you to marry against your wishes or to become a victim of Female Genital Mutliation (FGM).



CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION

Anyone under the age of 18 is a child in law. No one should persuade, manipulate, deceive or force you into sexual activity in exchange for things that you might want or need (gifts, drugs, money, status, belonging or affection).



BULLYING

No one should make you feel scared. They should not either intentionally or indirectly harm, intimidate or coerce you either in person or online (social media, messaging or email).



DISCRIMINATION

No one should be treated badly because of difference in age, disability, gender, ethnicity, sexual orientation or religion. Difference shoud be respected.



RADICALISATION

No one should try to persuade or recruit you to adopt increasingly extreme political, religious or other ideologies to support or engage in violent extremism or terrorism.



NEGLECT

Whoever looks after you should not neglect you. You should know that you are cared for.



MODERN DAY SLAVERY

Are you or is someone you know being exploited - "owned" - by another person or group.



CHILD CRIMINAL EXPLOITATION E.G. COUNTY LINES

Are you or is someone you know carrying drugs or delivering packages? Are you or is someone you know being threatened to carry out criminal activity.
