So, how do you break the Seals? Easy. Interpret the symbol. See, when white horse rider was interpreted by the Prophet to be the spirit of antichrist, and he connected it with the history, the Word, the age, that broke that Seal.

[Ed: Brother Blewett breaks the First Seal.] That's one less Seal. But This is still sealed.

That each Seal, the symbol is what breaks It. And we need to get to the back, so you must interpret every symbol to break every Seal. And the symbol came by Vision. Correcto? Correcto.

John saw a Vision, white horse rider, a bow with no arrow. The symbols were Visions. But the Seventh Seal, no symbol.

Now we didn't know it, Brother Coleman had to help us, but while Brother Branham was preaching "The Seventh Seal," he reached back to November '55 and pulled the Tent Vision under the Seventh Seal and said, 'See? It slides right in.' And we would have missed it, but Brother Coleman said, he was giving us the symbol of the Seventh Seal, which was a Vision.

And when you realise it, it's obvious, because you cannot interpret a Seal if there's no symbol. Nothing to interpret. And this Seal was so great, there was no symbol written. But Brother Branham gave us the symbol. And when he got the Vision, in '55, he had no idea it was the symbol of the Seventh Seal. But on 24th March, he caught it and slid it under there. Now we've got a symbol. And Brother Branham interpreted the first Six for us, so everything rested on the Seventh Seal. 'And Brother Branham, don't explain It. Take the secret to the grave.'



- Take a bus (17B) from Bebabeba stage heading to Kasarani/Mwiki.
- Get off at the Regional Centre Training Institute, opposite Kasarani Police Station.

By Plane

- Take exit 8 from A2
