Detailed description: This system covers measures 40 to 42. The mandolin part begins with a glissando (gliss.) over a series of eighth notes. The piano part features a forte (f) dynamic marking and includes a melodic line in the right hand and a bass line in the left hand.

Mdn. 43 Accel. Tempo primo, inquieto

Detailed description: This system covers measures 43 to 45. The mandolin part has an acceleration (Accel.) marking and then returns to the original tempo (Tempo primo, inquieto). The piano part has a piano-piano (pp) dynamic marking and features a complex rhythmic accompaniment.
