What is Sailing Club Manager?

Sailing Club Manager (SCM) is an easy-to-use internet-based software application that St Mawes Sailing Club uses to administer its membership database, manage Club subscriptions and activities, run Junior Sail Training (JST) bookings, advertise sailing and social events, and communicate with our members and the outside world.

We realise that some people may need help to use SCM and so we have written this user guide to help you navigate the website and explain how to use the various functions.

SCM will make it much easier and less time-consuming to manage the Club's activities and provide a far more effective way of communicating with Club members.

As well as making the business of administering the Club's affairs more efficient and cost effective, there are also many benefits of using SCM for our members. Some examples of things that you will be able to do are:

- View and interact with the Club website
- View and change your personal information, including login details and password, and what information you would like visible to other members
- Apply for membership of the Club
- Renew your annual membership subscription and pay other fees
- View the Club calendar and sailing schedule
- Book tickets for Club events
- Keep your individual, family and boat records up-to-date

SCM offers a wide range of facilities, which we hope to make maximum use of as we get more familiar with the software. To start with, however, we will be keeping it to the basics!

The Sailing Club Manager Website


Almost all the things you need to do as a Club member are managed through the StMSC website. The image below shows the main or 'home' page for St Mawes Sailing Club. The web address for this page is www.stmawessailing.co.uk. You can either click on this link to take you to the page now or copy the address and paste it into your usual internet browser. Remember to make it a favourite!

SCM is based on the internet, so you can visit the home page on any computer, tablet device or smart phone connected to the internet.

Your Personal Home Page

You can visit the public pages of the website without logging into the site but if you wish to access the members area or book something online (such as a JST course or an event) you will need to click 'login' at the top right of the screen. This will take you to the screen below:



If it is the first time that you have logged in, click the link 'Create an account now'. This will allow you to setup a password and login. If you already have a password, simply login.

Once you have logged in you will see your 'Personal Home Page' (shown on the next page). The various links are grouped under 7 sections, each dealing with a specific activity: Profile & Membership, Payments & Accounts, Club Directory, Bookings & Logbook, Volunteering, Crew Finder, Communication. The following paragraphs explain what each of the links covers.

Profile & Membership

This section allows you to insert personal information about you, your boats and your membership.

- [My Profile](#). This link allows you to insert your personal information as you wish, including a personal photo. By default, all details are shared with other Club members and will appear in the Membership Directory. However, you can choose to make any of the details completely private by selecting this option from the appropriate drop-down box.
- [My Login Details](#). This link allows you to change your login email address and password.
- [My Boats](#). This link allows you to record the boats that you own; you can add a new boat from this page.
- [My Membership](#). This section shows you a list of all your current membership details. It enables you to update your details and to renew any memberships that you currently hold. If you wish to change your membership type, then you will need to contact Jane Pearce, the Club Administrator, at office@stmawessailing.co.uk.
- [My Renewals](#). This link allows you to renew your membership.
- [My Data](#). Provides a summary of the personal information that the Club stores to allow us to communicate with you and provide services for you.

Payments & Accounts

This section provides details of invoices and any payments that you have made. It also allows you to setup GoCardless Payments.

- [My Invoices](#). This link shows you a list of invoices for any subscriptions and/or event tickets etc. that you have ordered. It contains details of what you need to pay and the payment options.
- [My Statement of Account](#). This link provides details of all the transactions you have made.
- [My GoCardless Setup](#). In order to provide members with an efficient method of paying membership fees and other bills, the Club has decided to offer the online Direct Debit facility provided by GoCardless. Many Clubs have adopted this payment method, which is simple to setup, easy to manage and secure. Following this link allows you to quickly setup your Direct Debit mandate, which you can then be use for all payments to the Club.

Club Directory

- [Member Directory](#). This link takes you to a directory listing of all current members of the Club and may include a picture and contact details, where these are available and have been authorised by the respective member. Clicking on the member's name shows their contact details and allows you to send them a personal email message direct from SCM. You can choose to be removed from this directory by contacting the Club Administrator or changing the settings in your profile (see My Profile section above).
- [Boat Directory](#). This link shows details and photographs (where they have been uploaded) of members' boats.

Bookings & Logbook

This section allows you to manage your bookings, sailing qualifications, crew requirements and, if you wish, record your sailing activities in a 'Logbook'.

- [Schedule](#). This link provides a list of the events/activities you have booked or volunteered to undertake.
- [My Bookings & Allocations](#). This link provides a list your upcoming reservations and bookings.
- [Book Event](#). This link takes you to the Book Online page and allows you to book events.
- [My Qualifications](#). This link allows you to provide a list of the qualifications you hold, such as First Aid, Powerboat etc.
- [My Crew](#). This section shows all the people for whom you pay or who pay for you, and contacts that you have a defined relationship. It also provides da list of contacts that you have added to your crew list via the Member Directory.
- [My Logbook](#). The section allows you to record your sailing activates in a personal "logbook".

Volunteering

SCM allows the Club to setup and manage duty rosters for the likes of our Safety Boats, Race Office and JST courses. It is only relevant for Club members who undertake these duties.

- [Duty Roster](#). This link provides visibility of all the Duty Rosters.
- [My Duties](#). Provides details of any duties you have agreed to undertake.
- [My Duty Swaps](#). Allows you to swap or transfer duties with other members.

Crew Finder

SCM enables you to request a crew or volunteer to crew for another Club member at a forthcoming event.

- [My Availability](#). Allows you to specify when you would be available to crew for other Club members.
- [Crew Available](#). This link provides a summary of recent crew requests you have made, and any potential matches.
- [Crew Wanted](#). This link allows you to specify the details of crew you are seeking.

Communication

This section allows you to send and receive emails from other Club members, post messages on the Forum page and decide which Mailing List you would like to receive.

- [Messages](#). This link allows you to compose emails to other Club members and shows a record of all messages sent and received.
- [Surveys & Polls](#). This link records a list of upcoming, open and recent polls and surveys.
- [Mailings & Lists](#). This link provides access to all the Club Mailings that have been sent. It also enables you to opt in or out of the Club's discretionary mailing lists. Your data will be held securely and not be shared with any other organisation without your explicit consent in line with the StMSC Data Privacy Policy (<https://test.stmawessailing.co.uk/legal-1/data-policy>).
- [Forum Posts](#). This link provides a record of all the messages you have posted on the Forum.

How to Book an Event or Course

There are two ways to find information about and book upcoming Club events on the StMSC website (see image below):

The first way is to click on “Calendar” on the StMSC home page, you should see a page similar to that shown below. In this case, ‘All’ events have been selected, but you can filter the view by choosing a particular calendar, such as JST. Once you have found a bookable event that you are interested in attending, click the “book” link against the event. This will take you to a booking screen. **Note that not all events require you to book a place and some events require payment on booking and others do not or are not chargeable.**

Junior Sail Selecting one or more tickets and clicking 'Add to Cart' takes you to the payment page, where you can select payment by either BACS or GoCardless (which is the preferred method). If an event is Free but still 'Bookable' (perhaps because the Club wants an indication of likely attendance) the process is exactly the same – but there is nothing to pay!
