Fairy tale released in seven languages

The fairy tale “Bill Goats and the Forest” is describing the cynical world view of the technocrats. The English version has been shipped to 34 different countries and due to high demand, it is being released in six more languages this week.

The fairy tale book “Bill Goats and the Forest” by the Norwegian author Frode Burdal Klevstul was released in June this year. Since the author was interviewed by James Corbett and some other alternative media channels, there has been

a great demand for the book.

– It has been shipped to 34 different countries, and I have received great feedback. Several people have contacted me and requested a version in their own language. Some has even started to translate the book themselves, as they would like to read it for their children, says Frode Burdal Klevstul.

The book is published by Curious Creators (formerly Mpathic publishing), which is a small publishing company owned by Frode and his life partner Miriam Ekelund, who is also an author. They had not planned on translating the book

to other languages but decided to do so due to high demand and the urgency to reach as many people as possible with the message.

This week the fairy tale has been released in the following languages: Spanish, Portuguese, French, Swahili, German and Norwegian.

–We hope that people across the world will see and stand together against the tyranny. Our leaders are trying to divide us by gender, ideology, nationality, ethnicity and in any other way. The most powerful thing we can do, is to unite across borders, and make them feel

that they have millions of eyes watching and documenting every step they take, says Frode Burdal Klevstul and adds on saying.

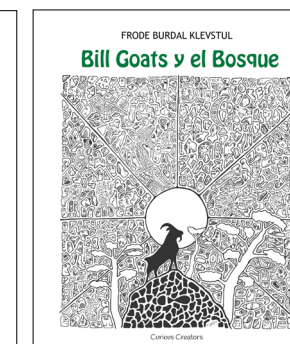
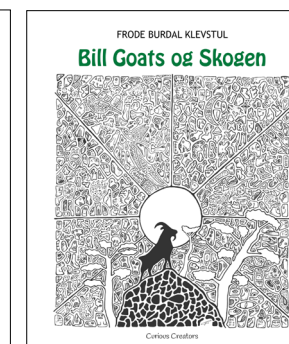
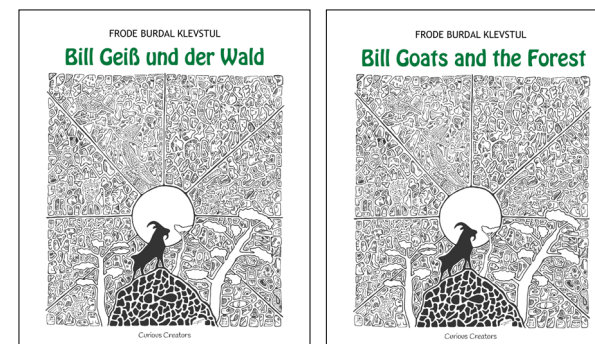
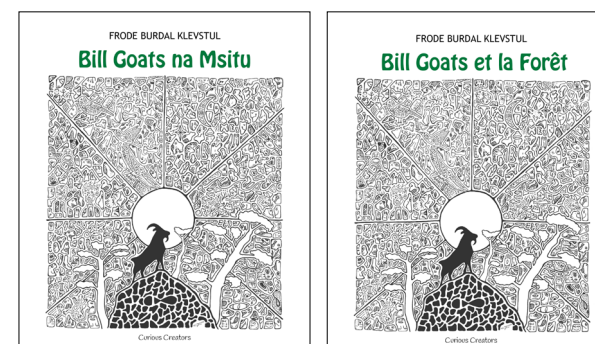
