## Introduction

This guide supports professional development based on the Cube Tube video *Working Mathematically Anthem*. To find it, from the FMC home page click *Cube Tube* and look for it in the Video Library.

The video provides visual data from classrooms using investigations to drive learning. This chart shows some of those investigations by name. There is at least one photo in the video for each of these investigations/activities. A number in brackets indicates the total number of photos for that item.

One way to begin your maths content exploration is to watch the video through looking for a photo of students about the same age as yours. Most photos will suggest which investigation is involved.
