

Dear Dr. Wolfgang Holl,

Thank you for your letter of June 29, 1983; classification Nr III-611-Tunçay.

I have published almost exclusively in Turkish. But to give you an idea about my work, I am sending you, (in English)

- an offprint of a book review which I wrote in the Bulgarian Etudes balkaniques, 1979, nr. 1,
- another book-review by a colleague of the first edition of my study on the Turkish Left,
- copy of a paper (as yet unpublished) I contributed to a seminar in USA: Marxism in Turkey,
- a lengthy resume that I specially prepared for you of my latest book: the Turkish Single-Party Experience.

There was no staff member or expert on Turkish History and Politics at the Stanford University, while I was there in 1979-80. I mainly worked alone on the Turkish material at the Hoover Institution. However, I audited a course given by Professor Mark Mancall on the History of Socialisms, as I myself used to give a parallel course at home. I suppose, you may ask Prof. Mancall's opinion about me.

I hope these additional material will be sufficient for your Selection Committee to reach a decision on my application.
