(Legal ones: T.İ.P. - Turkish Workers' Party; T.S.P. - T.Socialist R; T.S.İ.P. - T.Socialist Workers' P.; T.E.P. - T.Toilers' P. Illegal ones: T.K.P.M.L. - T.Communist P. Marxist Leninist; T.İ.İ.K.P. - T.Revolutionary Workers'-Peasants' P.; T.H.K.O. - T.People's Liberation Army; T.H.K.C. - T.People's Liberation Front.)

In addition to these 9 organizations, various independent circles around certain publication concerns, some students' and professional associations and trade unions ought also evaluated. The Turkish Marxist Left being thus scattered into small factions, has no likelihood to come to political power in the foreseeable future. However, the movement is quite strong among student circles and has some marginal hold in working class.
