

TO THE THIRD CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATION OF TURKISH WORKERS IN FEDERAL GERMANY (FIDEF)

Esteemed friends,

The Central Committee of the Communist Party of Turkey warmly greets the IIIrd Congress of FİDEF.

Our workers abroad are also a part of the working class of Turkey. They have emigrated to foreign countries because they were the victims of dependence on NATO and imperialism, because of unemployment and inability to make ends meet. They have been working for long years under the exploitation of imperialist monopolies. They are ill-treated and have few rights. The RPP-dominated government, like all governments before it, regards them only as a "foreign-exchange machine".

Our workers in Federal Germany are not and cannot be isolated from the political developments and events in our country. THE 27TH OF APRIL TRIAL AND THE URGENCY OF SOLIDARITY

A new court case has been instigated against Ahmet Tastan, responsible editor of "Ürün" Publishing House, under fascist article 141. The hearing will take place on the 27th of April. The new case is aimed at transforming the TKP Programme trial into a "secret organisation" investigation. Ahmet Tastan previously stood trial at the Istanbul Second Criminal Court under fascist article 142 for the legal publication of the TKP Programme. At the session of this trial on the 26th of January 1979, an important development took place due to national and international solidarity. The Court upheld the unconstitutionality of article 142 and an application was made to the Constitutional Court for the repeal of this fascist article. The Constitutional Court, however, refused to consider this application after a stormy sitting. Nevertheless, pressure from democratic, progressive forces forced a proposal for the abolition of fascist articles 141 and 142 onto the parliamentary agenda. The proposal was submitted by the independent MP for Mardin province, Nurettin Yılmaz. The statement by the Chairman of the Justice Party, Süleyman Demirel, following the coming of fascist articles 141 and 142 onto the parliamentary agenda clearly shows the big role played by the mounting pressures and attacks of the reactionary-fascist forces in this unconstructive decision by the Constitutional Court. Demirel said, "When articles 141 and 142 begin to be debated in parliament, we will declare war." (Tercüman, 30 March 1979)

In the light of these developments, the 27th of April hearing and the proposal of the parliamentary agenda for the lifting of fascist articles 141 and 142 assume great significance for all progressive forces, socialists, communists and social democrats, for all those on the side of freedom and democratic rights. Both events are an opportunity for the reactionary-fascist forces to increase anti-communist attacks against all democratic forces and organisations. In order to prevent this, the 27th of April trial must be forced into a retreat and repulsed. Fascist article 141, like article 142, must be made to be taken to the Constitutional Court for anullment. The repulsing of this offensive will facilitate the overcoming of the resistance of the reactionary-

fascist forces in parliament, the formation of a majority on the side of democratic freedoms, and the dumping of these fascist legislation onto the rubbish heap of history.

From this point of view, it is necessary, as it is urgent, to widen the struggle for the abolition of articles 141 and 142 and to strengthen solidarity on a national and international scale with "Ürün" Publishing House and its director Ahment Taştan, against the 27th of April trial. The results of the national and international solidarity which developed and strengthened at the previous trials are plain to see. The statements of various organisations in recent days demanding the abolition of fascist articles 141 and 142 show that solidarity to be strengthening. In fact the Congress of the Union of Writers of Turkey, the Bar Association of Turkey on its 101st anniversary and the Society of Contemporary Lawyers of Turkey have all repeated their demands for the abolition of articles 141 and 142.

The struggle against these fascist articles is an inseparable part of the struggle against the fascist escalation, imperialism and the aggressive NATO pact.
